Conditions of Entry

1. The "Beyond Group" National Open Exhibition 2008 of Digital Projection Photography is open to all photographers in the UK.
2. There are Three sections - General Colour, General Monochrome and Nature.
3. The image and all elements within it must be the sole work of the author. Images made completely by computer software and having no photographic content will not be accepted.
4. Images must be submitted in JPEG file format only, and they should be put in folders titled COL, MON and NAT onto a CD. Do not share disks.
5. Each image must be named as follows: MYNAME%MYTITLE.jpg. Example JoeBloggs%Misty Morning.jpg
6. Each CD must be clearly labelled with the author's name, postcode and e-mail address (if applicable) by using a fine permanent marker pen on the top surface, do not use sticky labels.
7. Images will be projected at 1024 pixels x 768 pixels. Images projected in Portrait mode must be no more than 768 Pixels high. If your image is less than the maximum in any direction the unused area should be filled with a black or grey background. For more information about sizing your image visit our website.
8. Images should be submitted using Adobe 1998 colour space to ensure the best projection of the images.
9. Images not presented exactly as above will not be presented to the judges correctly.
10. All selected images will be posted on the website until 30th June 2009 and all accepted images will automatically be sent to all exhibition entrants on CD, this CD will also include the catalogue. Additional CD's can be ordered at £5.00 each.
11. Copyright of the image remains with the author and he/she must accept that his/her work could be downloaded from the site.
The organisers will take every precaution to protect the copyright of the image when viewed on the website by making them as small as possible.
12. The Beyond Group may also show accepted images around local EAF clubs.
13. All submitted materials will be destroyed by 30th September 2008 and not returned. Entrants details will be kept on file for 2 years.
14. Please complete the enclosed Entry form and include with the CD and entry fee in your envelope. Entries will not be accepted without the correct entry fee.

Nature - Definition

The use of the photographic process to depict scenes from all branches of natural history except anthropology, archaeology, geology and meteorology. One or more organisms living free and unrestricted in a natural or adopted habitat. Captive or domesticated animals and cultivated plants are not eligible. Any manipulation must not alter the actual species portrayed.
